ORDER

This matter having come before the Council on Affordable Housing by application of Plaintiff, Meadowview at Millington for an Order granting discovery-consisting of written interrogatories and depositions relating to sewer capacity and vacant developable land in the Township of Passaic and for an Order to impose restraints on the granting of any development approvals for vacant land in the Township of Passaic and the Council having heard oral argument on November 3, 1986 and also having considered the briefs and exhibits submitted by the various parties, and for the reasons set forth at length in the Council's written opinion of even date;

IT IS on this day of 1987

ORDERED that plaintiff's request for discovery is hereby denied;
and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Passaic Township, the Passaic Township Board of Adjustment and any of their officers, agents or employees are hereby restrained from granting any development approvals including but not limited to site plan,

subdivision or variances which involve the use of vacant land in the Township of Passaic; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect, unless otherwise modified, until the Council either grants or denies Passaic's petition for substantive certification.
