
ORDER

This matter having come before the Council on Affordable Housing upon the application of the Township of Piscataway, Middlesex County, New Jersey, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, for an Order exempting the property known as site 60 within the Township of Piscataway from the terms of the Council's Order restraining the development of vacant land in Piscataway, with Philip Lewis Paley, Esquire of Kirsten, Simon, Friedman, Allen, Cherin & Linken, Esquires, appearing on behalf of the Township of Piscataway and Louis Nikolaidis, Esquire of Clifton & Schwartz, Esquires, appearing on behalf of the Civic League of Greater New Brunswick and all objectors and interested parties having been notified and given an opportunity to be heard and the Council having considered all moving papers and responsive papers; and it appearing that there is no objection to the request; and the Council having determined that the site known as site 60 is unsuitable for multi-family development with low and moderate income housing; and the Council having further determined that it is appropriate therefore to exempt the site known as site 60 from the terms of the Council's Order restraining the development of vacant land in Piscataway;

and for further good cause shown;

IT IS on this 19th day of January, 1988

ORDERED that the property known as site 60 in the Township of Piscataway is hereby exempted from the terms of the Council's Order imposing restraints upon the development of vacant land in Piscataway.
