This matter having come before the New Jersey Council on Affordable Housing upon Application of Theodore E. B. Einhorn, Esquire, on behalf of the Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother Health-care Corporation (SSMHCC) and St. Francis Lifecare Center (SFLCC) for an Order exempting the SSMHCC and SFLCC from the terms of the Council's Order dated November 3, 1986 with Steven Hansbury, Esquire, appearing on behalf of the Township of Denville; Guliet D. Hirsch, Esquire, appearing on behalf of Stonehedge Association and Maurice Soussa appearing pro se; and all objectors and interested parties having been notified of the hearing and given an opportunity to be heard; and the Council having considered

all documents and papers filed; and the Council having heard oral argument at its public meeting on November 23, 1987 and for the reasons stated in the Council's written Opinion of even date; and for further good cause shown

IT IS ON THIS        day of December, 1987

ORDERED that the property known as Block 50001, Lot 3 on the Township of Denville Tax Map is hereby exempted, subject to the below described condition, afrom the terms of the Council's Order Imposing Restraints upon the allocation of sewer capacity dated November 3, 1987; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-named property is exempted solely for the purpose of constructing a medical office building as set forth in the SSMHCC moving papers. This exemption shall not apply if the property is developed for any other purpose; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SFLCC's request for an exemption of Block 50001, Lots 1 and 2 is hereby denied.
