CIVIL ACTION
ORDER

An order restraining the use of certain specified sites in Piscataway Township having been issued by the Superior Court, Chancery Division, on December 11, 1987; and

Piscataway Township having been subsequently transferred to the Council on Affordable Housing, for the purpose of the Council's mediation and review process; and

The Council having continued the restraints previously imposed by the Superior Court; and

At its public meeting of Monday, June 6, 1988 the Council having granted substantive certification to Piscataway Township; said certification contingent upon Piscataway's enactment of ordinances implementing its fair share plan within 45 days of the date of certification;

IT IS on this 6th day of June, 1988

ORDERED that:

1. The restraints imposed by the Superior Court shall continue until such time as Piscataway enacts the required ordinances implementing its fair share plan within the statutory 45 day period;
2. In the event Piscataway fails to enact the required ordinances in a timely manner, the restraints shall continue pending further order of the Council.
