ORDER


This matter having been opened to the Council on Affordable Housing (the Council) by applications filed by Calton Homes, Inc. (Calton), on April 20, 1989 and the Public Advocate, on April 19, 1989, seeking the transfer of additional issues to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) with regard to Middletown Township's petition for substantive certification; and

The Council having considered all papers filed in support and opposition to the applications, and for the reasons set forth at length in its Opinion of this date:

IT IS on this *10th* day of June, 1989

ORDERED that applications to expand the issues transferred to the OAL, filed with the Council by Calton Homes, Inc. and the Public Advocate, are hereby denied; with the exception of the issue of the suitability under Council regulations of the five sites selected by Middletown for use in its plan as locations for scattered site sales units, which issue is hereby

transferred to the OAL for review in conjunction with those other issues previously transferred.
