

Resolution Granting An Extension Of Time To
The Conditional Substantive Certification

WHEREAS, by the Resolution adopted June 5, 1989 the Council on Affordable Housing granted New Providence Borough's petition for substantive certification conditional approval, which becomes a part here of and is attached here to; and

WHEREAS, New Providence Borough was required to satisfy the conditions listed in the resolution within 60 days of the date of adoption; and

WHEREAS, New Providence Borough was unable to meet all of the conditions within the 60 day limit for the following reasons:

1. The consultant planner for the Borough suffered an extended illness and was unable to work on the fair share plan for several weeks;
2. The Borough had some difficulty finalizing certain details in the agreement with one developer, requiring additional COAH administered mediation between the Borough and the developer; and

WHEREAS, New Providence Borough requested in a timely manner an extension of time to September 11, 1989, in order to address all conditions; and


WHEREAS, a copy of the request was submitted to participants in mediation; and

WHEREAS, no participant in mediation objected to New Providence Borough's request; and

WHEREAS, COAH determined that circumstances under which this request is made are unique and valid.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVE, that COAH hereby grants an extension of the conditional substantive certification of New Providence Borough to September 11, 1989.
