

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, by decision dated June 6, 1988 the Council on Affordable Housing (COAH) restrained the allocation of water capacity within the Shorelands Water Company's franchise area within Holmdel Township, as a result of COAH's determination that water capacity constituted a scarce resource within the Township; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated July 2, 1990 from Michael P. Walsh, P.E., President of Shorelands, COAH was advised that Shorelands' contract with the New Jersey Water Supply Authority for receipt of water from the Manasquan River Reservoir was effective as of July 1, 1990, and that Shorelands now had sufficient water capacity to service the Holmdel franchise area; and

WHEREAS, COAH had previously recognized that the implementation of Shorelands' contract for such water could obviate the necessity for scarce resource water restraints within Holmdel; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated July 3, 1990, COAH notified all parties on the Holmdel service list that COAH would discuss the lifting of the Holmdel scarce resource restraint at its public meeting of July 11, 1990; and


WHEREAS, COAH received no comments from any party with relation to lifting of said restraint; and

WHEREAS, COAH held a discussion of the lifting of the Holmdel scarce resource restraint at its July 11, 1990 meeting, and determined to lift the restraint, in light of the implementation of Shorelands' contract for Manasquan River Reservoir water, as detailed in the Walsh letter of July 2, 1990.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that for the reasons set forth at length at its July 11, 1990 public meeting, COAH hereby lifts the scarce resource restraint, previously imposed by decision dated June 6, 1988, on the allocation of water capacity within Shorelands' franchise area within Holmdel Township.
